Oral Methotrexate Indications Screen & Rules

This conversion of the original methotrexate screen will now function in Point n' Click format and screen for frequency issues:

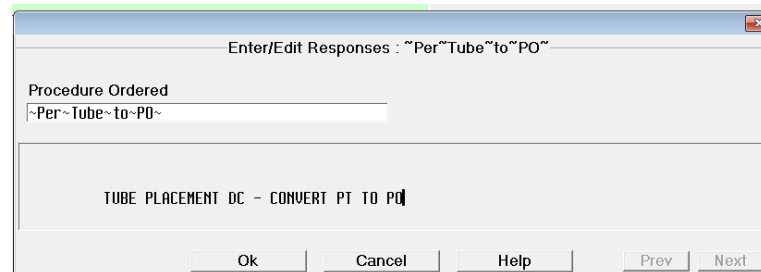
PO/Per Tube order evaluation process

To ensure appropriate routes on medication orders have been reviewed and/or converted when a patient is ordered to start or stop a per tube route, a new process has been developed:

- Providers will select order to insert/manage/discontinue a feeding tube. A set with a new 'dummy drug' will reflex (PO to PERTUBE or PERTUBE to PO, depending on the order):



- Orders entered via PK will generate a provider message to pharmacy, instead of a 'dummy drug' order:



- Pharmacy will receive the 'dummy drug' or message, review the profile and make any route edits as needed, and then complete or DC the 'dummy drug'/message.

PDOC (General Medicine, Surgery, Burn)

General Medicine:

- The chief Complaint will recall to subsequent notes in multiple PDOC note Templates
- They have added **Surgery Hand** and **Surgery Spine** in the Consultants field in multiple notes.
- “**Vital Signs reviewed**” is a new response located under the **Physical Exam Header**.
- The **Post Code Note** has been updated to facilitate documentation of Therapeutic Hypothermia.
- A new **Scores tab** has been added to house multiple scoring tools on the following provider note templates:
 - **Hospitalist Progress note**
 - **Nocturnist Hospitalist Note**
 - **Hospitalist Discharge Summary**
 - **Hospitalist Critical Care Note**
 - **Hospitalist Consultation**
 - **Hospitalist History & Physical**

Burn notes:

- There will be a new **required field** added to the **Burn Discharge Summary** for % wound closure as DC, this is to facilitate documentation necessary for the burn registry.

General Surgery:

- The Quality tab has been added to the following notes: **Bedside Post Proc Note** and the **Operative Note Full**

PDOC (Neurology & OB/GYN)

Neurology:

- The **Neuro Interventional Progress Note** has been updated to stay consistent with the progress note format.
- The **General tab** has been removed and the contents have been moved to the **Objective tab** under the **General header**.
- The **NIH Stroke Scale** has been updated by moving the applicable response field out of the scoring tool to prevent a score of 0 from appearing on the note output. Other changes include a Quality Section and updating field names for clarity.

OB/GYN:

- The OB Discharge Notes have been updated with an optional field to document the **PDMP** was reviewed. The following note templates are affected

 - OB Disch Undelivered
- RX drug data base reviewed is a new optional field with the following responses:
 - Yes
 - No
 - OR free text

PDOC (Oncology & Psychiatry)

Oncology/BMT:

- The following PDOC note templates have been updated.
- The **Chronic GVHD Assessment** header and free text enabled field has been added.
- **The field has recall capabilities to subsequent notes.** The following note templates have been updated:
 - **BMT Progress Note**
 - **BMT – History & Physical**
 - **Hema/Oncology Progress Note**
 - **Ped Hema/Oncology Prog Note**
 - **BMT Consultation**

- The **ECOG performance Scale** has been added under the **Physical Exam** header to facilitate documentation to support use of assistive devices.

Psychiatry:

- The **Psychiatric Medical H&P** note had been standardized with available responses in the Physical Exam header section.
- Multiple provider note templates have updated field names for clarity.
 - **Suicide detailed risk had changed to Suicide risk detailed assessment**
 - **Suicide & self-injury behave 3 mo, Has changed to 3 mo Suicide & Self Injury**
 - **Suicide & Self injury lifetime, Has changed to Lifetime Suicide & Self-injury**
- The Suicide Risk Detail Assessment is also available as an **add section** and as a **standalone template**.
- **TelePsych Consult**
 - The **Psychiatric Consultation Note** and the **Telehealth Psychiatric Consult** have been updated in the **Time Spent** (minute) field
 - 50% spent on counseling/consultation is a multi-select response with following responses: **Yes, No or Free Text**

Jaundice Treatment:

- The optional Bili tool has been added to calculate risk toward the development of hyperbilirubinemia in newborns over 35 week's gestational age.
- The **Hyperbilirubinemia Risk section** has been added under the **Objective tab** and affects the following note templates:
 - **Well baby – Admission H&P**
 - **Well baby – Progress Note**
- The **Bili tool calculator** includes the website with instructions to activate.
 - Be sure to hold the Control <CTRL> key and click the link to activate in the window.
- The **Bhutani risk stratification field** had the following responses:
 - **High risk**
 - **Low risk**
 - **High intermediated risk**
 - **Low intermediated risk**

The **Hyperbili risk level** has been updated.

Condition on Discharge:

- The following PDOC note template have been updated for clarity if read by the parents form the patient portal:
 - **Well Baby – Discharge Note**
 - **NICU Discharge Note**
- The **Well Baby** and **NICU** notes now contain additional maternal history and nursing data canned text.
