Appropriate Use Criteria (AUC)

Criteria for AUC:

- Patient with outpatient, Emergency Department, Same Day Surgery, and Observation status (and special Financial Class 01) with imaging orders placed under the 8 Clinical Priority Areas (CPA's): Headache, Hip pain, low back pain, cervical or neck pain, shoulder pain, cancer of the lung, coronary artery disease, suspected pulmonary embolism.
- Provider may have the following options:
 - Change Order to recommended exam
 - Change Order to alternative exam
 - Cancel Order
 - Continue Original Order
 - *At no time will the clinician be prevented from completing the order despite the guidance.*

Exceptions

- CDS screens will not launch for patients identified as Level 1 –ESI Triage priority/Trauma in ED. Need discussion on ED workflow to flag these patients immediately so that pop up won't appear for providers.

2. General Medical

I. Hospitalist H&P – Problem Focus

- This note has been updated with optional fields to document anticipated discharge and disposition.

II. Medication Update

- The medication field has been updated in multiple provider notes templates to show brand and generic medication names

III. Attestation Updates

- All provider documentation note templates with Attestations have been updated to add the use of optional attestation for use with Fellows.

3. Obstetrics

I. OB Delivery Note

- The blood loss at delivery field has been updated to provide clarity around the ACOG definition of post-partum hemorrhage. ACOG defines post – partum hemorrhage as **1000 mls OR a blood loss of < 1000 mls with signs/symptoms of hypovolemia.**

II. OBED Evaluation Note

- In some scenarios, the patient needs to be reevaluated multiple times prior to the OB provider making the decision to admit or discharge the patient. Re-Evaluation options have been added to the Diagnosis Assessment and Physical Tab.

III. OB Post – Partum Discharge Note

- The OB Post-Partum discharge Note has been updated to provide clarity for the type of laceration repair. “Repair Vaginal Laceration” has been updated to “Repair of Perineal Laceration”.

IV. OB Postpartum Progress Note

- A section to document additional post-partum blood loss has been added to the OB post-partum Progress Note. The first field will pull in any documented blood loss from the OB delivery note. The provider can delete the items that did not pull in previous documentation to prevent the text from appearing on the note output.

4. Pediatrics

I. Multiple Pediatric notes have been updated with the following

- Past Surgical History field has an added response:
 - Oral Surgery
 - History of Homelessness

5. Psychiatric Recertification:

a. Inpatient Psychiatric Recertification documentation will be removed from PDoc and should now be captured via the new standard order named “IP Psych Recertification

b. The following provider notes templates and sections **will be inactivated**:

- Psychiatric Recertification Note
- Psychiatric progress Note – **Recertification Section**
- Add section – **Psychiatric Recertification**

6. Cardiology: Structural Heart Consult Note:

• **The TAVR Consult note** has been renamed to **Structural Heart Consult note** and aids in DRG reimbursement and growth opportunities by providing comprehensive documentation present on admission findings. This aids in appropriately capturing the acuity of patients for risk stratification and TVT registry risk adjustment. This provider note template also captures data in one comprehensive note, which helps to eliminate provider dependent memory to document all pertinent findings.

- Ova & Parasite – information alert, soft stop
- Stool WBC & Stool Lactoferrin – new order screen with required indication for testing
- Giardia Antigen & Cryptosporidium Antigen – new order screen with alert for date of symptom onset and required indication for testing
- Stool Culture – new order screen with alert for date of symptom onset and required indication for testing
