# UA with Reflex to Culture Order

- When evaluating fever alone in a critically ill patient, urine cultures should only be evaluated in patients at risk of invasive infection:
  - Kidney transplant recipients
  - Neutropenic patients
  - Recent genitourinary surgery
  - Demonstrated evidence of obstruction
  - **ACTION:** If fever alone is selected as a symptom, provider will be asked for additional risk factor for invasive infection.
- Dysuria alone in patients who recently had a Foley catheter removal in the past 24-48 hours is not abnormal post-catheter removal and will self-resolve
  - **ACTION:** If dysuria is selected as the symptom, provider will be asked to re-evaluate need for culture in 24 hours

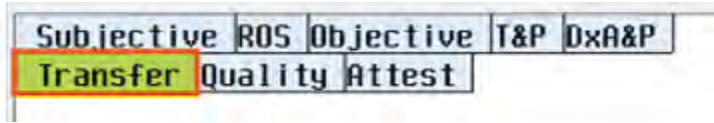

In order to capture the information on Disabilities due to CMS fallout, the Disability field is now Required. New group responses have been added to on all Psych Note Templates.


The new responses for the Disabilities field:
